Parking Policy

Effective from 1st May 2015

The church has three on-site parking spaces. In order to manage demand it is the policy of the church not to allow parking in general and we encourage use of local car parking sites within the city centre or to use another means of travelling to the site. We are located opposite the Stonebow bus interchange.

If you require on-site parking the following priorities will be applied:

1. Parking for church services (such as funerals) and the Minister.
2. Parking for authorised individuals, based on site, with a need for bringing a car on site on that particular day.
3. Contractors and other individuals carrying out work at the time.
4. Loading and unloading by users of the site.
5. Parking for disabled individuals (when possible based on the above).
6. All other circumstances.

Process:

1. Please contact the warden (01904 612171) or the “transforming central” project manager (01904 611020) richard.ramsden@centralmethodistyork.org.uk to enquire about parking for a particular day / time.
2. Within the order of parking priority all users of the site will be accorded equal opportunity.
3. If it is possible to accommodate your request your details will be recorded on the parking schedule (contact number & location on site) and a space booked for that date and time slot at the absolute discretion of the church.

Terms of use:

By making a booking you agree to the following terms of use:

1. That you will park within the marked bays and not overhang the public pavement.
2. If your vehicle is too long for a single bay you will need to book multiple bays.
3. That if asked during your booking you agree to swap the order of parked vehicles within ten minutes of being requested.
4. That you leave a means of identification visible on your vehicles dashboard (location or phone number).
5. That you allow other users ten minutes to move their vehicles to allow you to leave.
6. You agree that you will not leave the site whilst your vehicle is on site.
7. The church may need, at its absolute discretion, to cancel or curtail your booking either before or during your vehicle being on site. You will be required to move the vehicle per point 3.
8. If for whatever reason you fail to adhere to this policy you may be asked to remove your vehicle from site with immediate effect.
